The Sumarroca winery wins the Vinari d'Or for the best Catalan rosé: Posidonia 2017.

On Friday 5th October, the Auditori in Vilafranca del Penedès staged the sixth Vinari wine awards gala ceremony hosted by the journalists Txé Arana and Empar Moliner.

Just after 10pm, the hosts announced the Vinari d'Or 2018 award for the best Catalan rosé had gone to the Sumarroca winery and their wine Posidonia 2017. Sumarroca's wine expert Òscar Llombart collected the prize and told the members of the audience about the special qualities of the prize-winning wine. The wine is made from a variety of the Ull de Llebre grape from the Molí Coloma estate in Subirats. The pebbly soil gives the wine its unique freshness and personality. Posidonia 2017 is made using traditional methods and has pale pink hues, an intense and complex aroma with fruity notes of strawberry and sour apple, as well as floral notes of violet and rose.

The Sumarroca winery has been based in the Penedès since the early 1980s, spearheaded by an innovative family who have never forgotten the origins of the wine-growing tradition.
